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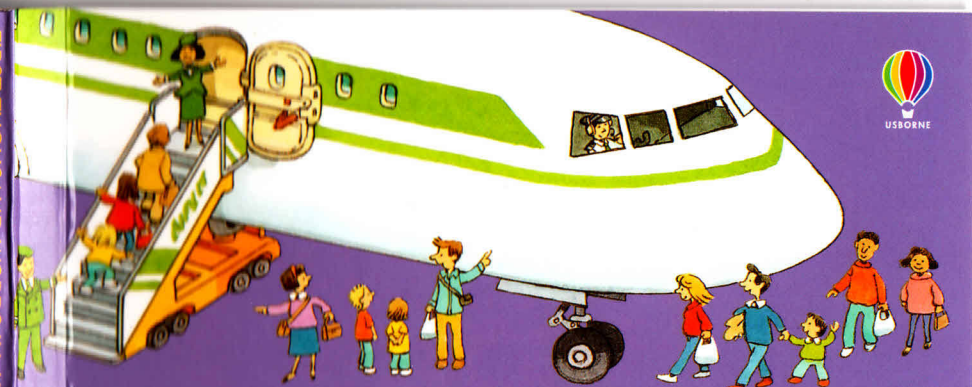

About kana signs

The words in this book are written in simple Japanese signs, called *kana*. Each *kana* represents a syllable. (A syllable is part of a word that is a separate sound, for example, "today" has two syllables: "to" and "day".)

Below you can see all the *kana* signs and find out which sounds they represent. There are also lots of tips to help you make these sounds like a Japanese person.

Japanese has two sets of *kana* signs, called *hiragana* and *katakana*. *Hiragana* signs are used for

In the lists above, signs with guides written in slanted letters (*like this*) are based on the ones above.

Pronunciation tips

Here are a few tips that will help you to say the *kana* signs above in a really Japanese way:

- wherever the pronunciation guide shows a, say this like the "a" in "father"
- say i like the "ee" in "meet"
- say u like the "oo" in "cuckoo"
- say e like the "e" in "end"
- say o like the "o" in "corn"
- when you see a line over a letter (for example *ō*), this shows the sound is long.

For other letters, say them as if they were part of an English word, but remember these tips:

- when you see r, say it as a soft "r" sound, halfway

the traditional sounds of Japanese. *Katakana* signs are used for words that Japanese has borrowed from other languages, such as "taoru", borrowed from the English word "towel".

Next to each *kana*, you can see a guide to how it is said. In the book, each Japanese word is shown in the same way, that is, in *kana* with a pronunciation guide based on the guides on this page. Japanese also uses more complicated signs, called *kanji* or "characters". You can find out about *kanji* on page 56.

As you can see, to make this new set of sounds you add a little mark to the *kana*.

between an "l" and an "r"

- when you see g, say it as in "garden"
- the (w) sound is shown with the "w" in brackets because you sometimes say "wo", and sometimes just "o". In this book, the pronunciation guide for each word will make clear which sound to make
- the fu sound is halfway between "foo" and "hoo"
- the n sound is on its own (at the bottom of each list) is a nasal "n" sound, much as if you had a cold.

In English, many words have a part that you stress, or say louder. For example, in the word "daisy", you stress "dai". In Japanese, you say each part of the word with the same stress.

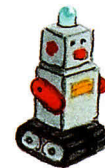
About this book

Looking at Japanese words

You will see that Japanese words are written with special signs. You can find out about these on the page opposite and on page 56. It will take you a little time to learn Japanese signs so, to help you, the Japanese word is also written in our alphabet.



Writing in Japanese

Traditionally, Japanese is written from right to left and top to bottom. This means you start a book at what to an English person is the back. In this book, everything is written from left to right, just as in English.

Saying and listening to Japanese words

Throughout this book you will find an easy how-to-say guide for each Japanese word, but the best way to learn how to speak Japanese is to listen to a Japanese speaker and repeat what you hear. You can listen to all the words in this book, spoken by a Japanese person, on the Usborne Quicklinks Website. Just go to www.usborne-quicklinks.com and type in the keywords "1000 japanese". To hear the words, you will need your Web browser (e.g. Internet Explorer or Netscape Navigator) and a programme that lets you play sound (such as RealPlayer® or Windows® Media Player). These programmes are free and, if you don't already have one of them, you can download them from Usborne Quicklinks. Your computer also needs a sound card but most computers already have one of these. Please read the **Internet note** for parents and guardians on page 56.

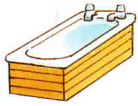

About kanji

The Japanese signs used in this book (see page two) are called kana, and they are based on sounds. They are simple signs that you use when you first learn Japanese. Normally, they are used mixed in with some other, more complicated signs, called kanji or "characters". Each kanji represents a word or an idea.

When people first started to write, they used simple pictures of things to show what they were writing about. This is how kanji started, and some kanji signs still look like what they represent. For example: 木 this kanji means "tree". It can also be written using kana, き, and said as "ki". 森 this kanji means "forest". Notice that it is made from three "tree" kanji.

There are many kanji. To read a newspaper, you have to know around 2000. It takes a few years to learn them, so it is best to start with kana, learning a few of these at a time.

About the word list

In this list, you can find all the Japanese words in the book. For each double page, the Japanese words are shown written in our alphabet. Next to each word you can see its translation (what it means in English).

The translations match the pictures, so if the picture shows leaves, the translation is "leaves", not "leaf". In Japanese, though, there is usually no difference between singular and plural (one and many), so "leaf" and "leaves" are both "ha".

To know how you should say the Japanese words, look at page two or go to the Usborne Quicklinks Website at www.usborne-quicklinks.com and type in the keywords "1000 Japanese". There you can listen to all the words in this book, spoken by a native Japanese person.
